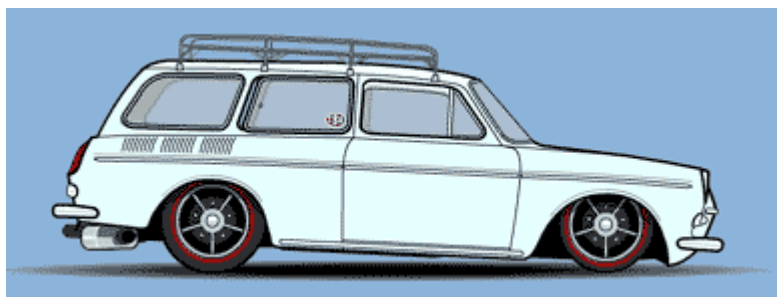
Look forward to seeing everybody at these events coming up. Let's get out and show our colors and let the NON-VW people know what we have.

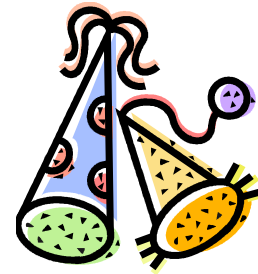
